LOGAN COUNTY AGGREGATION FOR ELECTRIC & GAS

The Village of West Liberty will stay with IGS for natural gas at \$.667 per CCF (If you have questions or want to OPT-OUT or join the aggregate call **877-353-0162**.)

Electric Aggregation The Logan County Electric Aggregation Program expires in December. The new rate will be .09260 with Dynegy for 12 months. You have the option to opt out.

UTILITY SOLICITORS ALL solicitors must register with the Clerks office prior to soliciting within the village. If they cannot show you a blue card from the Village, **they are not registered**. You do not have to open your door to any solicitor, at any time. We have had several reports that solicitors have said they were sent by the Village and were representing the aggregation. **They were NOT**. The Village did not send these people door to door, and they did not represent the aggregation in any way. These solicitors work on comission from how many people they can sign up. They are very persuasive and might make you feel that you must make a decision right at that moment. They will give you a lot of information and not try to explain in a way that you can understand. They do not care about your best interest, only their commission. If a solicitor ever makes you feel uncomfotable or threatened in any way, **please call 911**.
