Membership: We currently have 66 paid members which is up from 46 last year. This is a 43% increase!

By-laws: We have taken a step back with the changes to the by-laws. We will be meeting with an accountant and possibly an attorney just to make sure we are doing everything correctly. As soon as we are finished with all of those steps, we will bring them back for a vote. We want to make sure and keep this set up correctly as a non-profit.

There will be an award presentation on April 4th at 10am at their West Liberty location . Marie's Candy will honor Heather and feature her favorite candy and Stoner's Ice Cream Parlor will create a new sundae based on her candy choice.


